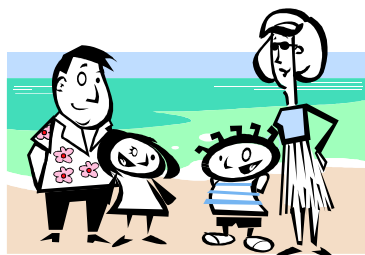


Praise Christian School GUIDELINES FOR FIELD TRIP BEHAVIOR

1. Field trip coordinator is responsible for coordinating the field trip only.
2. Parents are responsible for the behavior of their own children. However, if you witness unacceptable behavior, please bring this to the attention of the appropriate parent. The parent may not have seen what you saw. Do this in a kind and discreet manner.
3. Remain as a group behind the tour guide.
4. Participants are expected to stay within designated boundaries. If none have been given, please consider how you would want a guest in your home to behave. Remember that at the tour site we are guests and should consider our behavior in that light.
5. Tour site equipment is off-limits unless the host specifically invites the participants to handle same. Teach your children to stand and walk with their hands behind their back. Even as adults this helps us not to handle all the tempting items!
6. Participants are expected to be respectful of the tour guides by listening attentively and quietly. Some tours may provide information more advanced than your child can handle. Encourage the child to listen explaining that you will help him/her understand later.
7. Tour guides should be addressed in an appropriate manner - Mrs., Mr., Sir, Ma'am, etc.
8. Families are encouraged to write *thank you letters*. This could be incorporated nicely into a writing lesson. If you are unsure of the mailing address of the tour site, please ask the field trip coordinator.



NOTE: As much as we trust that there will not be offenses on our field trips, it does happen. Sometimes this is due to a sincere oversight, and with knowledge correction would have taken place.



- To avoid recurrence of inappropriate behavior, the offending families will be notified.
- If such behavior is repeated on a second field trip, the children and their family will be restricted from participating.

We believe that it is the desire of our home school families to shed favorable light on home schooling, Praise Christian School, and most of all, our Lord. Following these guidelines, our home school field trips should be safe, enjoyable, and educational, and we will be invited back! Let's all work together on our field trips.
